7 All boats must carry scales and a bag or sling to weigh heaviest fish. In addition all large fish to be measured in CM (rays to be measured across the wings).

8 Participation in all of the above is entirely at owners/skippers own risk. It is recommended that lifejackets should be worn at all times.

9 Communication in all club events is via VHF Channel 8.

10 All the above events may be subject to occasional change by the boat convener in the interest of safety and productive fishing.
